- Over 60 years old vines
- Harvested into cases and selected by hand in the winery
- Matured in whiskey barrels for 18 months
- 12 months in the bottle
- Eye catching features with wax capsule
- Limited only 2,660 bottles

Why whisky barrels?

- The whisky has significantly reduced the tannins of the barrel without closing the pores of the barrel. The wine can benefit from improved micro-oxygenation - with reduced tannins and subtle vanilla notes.
- The wine gets a round & creamy texture on the palate
- Minimal residual flavors of the whiskey, from the pores of the wood increase the complexity and complexity of the wine.

VINEYARD: The vineyard is located in San Román de Hornija at an altitude of **720 m**. The soils are sandy with large stones. Clay and deep subsoils.

TASTING: Very aromatic wine, with nuances of ripe black fruit, spices, chocolate, toasted nuances (smoke). Structured in the mouth but very fatty and with sweet tannins, with a lot of volume and a pleasant finish.
